LAKE COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT (LAKELAND) (COUNTYWIDE 162 PCTS)

Proposed Bond Issue - \$40,000,000 (Est. 0.4M) - Purchasing sites and for the purpose of all or part of the cost of purchasing sites and for the erection, furnishing, and equipment of buildings, including buildings used for Applied Engineering and Manufacturing, Math, and Student Readiness and Support, and for the acquisition or construction of any property which the board of trustees of a community college district is authorized to acquire or construct, including infrastructure and improvements, and repaying moneys previously borrowed, advanced, or granted and expended for such purpose to issue and sell bonds of the College District - 28 years - commencing 2018

MENTOR CITY 4D (1 PCT)

Shall the sale of wine & mixed beverages be permitted for sale on Sunday between the hours of ten a.m. and midnight by Aashil Inc. dba Convenient Food Mart, an application for D-6 liquor permit, holder of a C-1 and C-2 liquor permit authorizing off premise sales who is engaged in the business of a convenient store at 4680 Corduroy Rd., Mentor, OH 44060 in this precinct?

MENTOR-ON-THE-LAKE CITY (4 PCTS)

Proposed Charter Amendment - Shall Article XII, Section 12.04 Police Operations 1.5 Mill Levy be continued for another five years commencing 2019 tax year?

Proposed Charter Amendment - Shall Article III, Section 5 be amended to provide for the Vice Presidential of Council to have the authority to perform the duties of the President of Council in the absence of the President of Council?

Proposed Charter Amendment - Shall Article IV, Section 1 be amended to provide that the Mayor of the City of Willoughby upon election shall commence and assume office on the first day of January following the Mayor's election?

Proposed Charter Amendment - Shall Article VI, Section 5 be amended to delete and eliminate in its entirety this Section 5 and its language reading "This article and all ordinances, rules, and regulations shall be liberally construed to give effect to the beneficial distribution of population, and the orderly development, improvement and general welfare of the City?"

WILLOWICK CITY (9 PCTS)

Proposed Charter Amendment - Shall Article IX, titled Taxation (Section 9.3, Municipal Income Tax) of the Charter of the City of Willowick be amended to provide that the Council shall have the power to levy a municipal income tax at a rate not to exceed two and one-half percent (2.5%)?

WILLOWICK CITY 1A (1 PCT)

Shall the sale of wine and mixed beverages be permitted for sale on Sunday between the hours of ten a.m. and midnight by JCC2 Inc. dba The C Store, an applicant for a D-6 liquor permit, holder of a C-1 and C-2 liquor permit authorizing off premises sales who is engaged in the business of a convenient store at 31905 Vine Street, Willowick, Ohio 44095 in this precinct?

FAIRPORT HARBOR VILLAGE (2 PCT)

3.9 Mills Renewal Levy - Current Operating Expenses - Five Years - Commencing 2018 tax year

KIRTLAND HILLS VILLAGE (1 PCT)

Proposed Charter Amendment - Shall Article X, Section 10.4 Transfer from Capital Improvement Fund to General Fund be added to the Village Charter which shall read as follows: Notwithstanding the restrictions set forth in Section 10.3 as to disbursements from the Capital Improvement Fund, the Council by ordinances passed by not less than a two-thirds vote of all members may authorize transfers from the Capital Improvement Fund not to exceed five hundred thousand (\$500,000) in any fiscal year?

WAITE HILL VILLAGE (1 PCT)

Proposed Charter Amendment - Shall Article X, Section 2.2 be amended to require the Mayor to provide notice and an opportunity to be heard to an employee prior to the imposition of discipline on the employee if the discipline is a suspension, transfer, reduction in rank, or discharge from employment?

1.5 Mills Renewal Levy - Roads - five years - commencing 2019 tax year

PAINESVILLE TOWNSHIP (12 PCTS)

1.95 Mills Additional Levy - Roads, bridges, trails, walkways etc. - continuing period of time - commencing 2018 tax year.
