Who are we?

Ohio Advocates for Medical Freedom (OAMF) is a non-partisan group advocating for your right to freely accept or decline any medical treatment or procedure. OAMF is composed of ordinary people who have come together with one goal in mind: the preservation of medical freedom.

We are a diverse group of people with a variety of professions including doctors, nurses, pharmacists, engineers, lawyers, and other professions. We are all concerned citizens, and many of us are parents. We have learned that the only way to stop medical mandates and the infringement on medical rights is to organize and push back against bad legislation and policies. We base our strategies in fact and truth and present that information to the public and legislators.

What do we want to accomplish?

Ohio Advocates for Medical Freedom is a statewide grassroots organization committed to protecting control over our own bodies. We seek to provide factual and current information about legislation that either threatens or protects informed consent and medical freedom. We strive to stop any legislation that infringes on those rights, and support legislation that seeks to preserve them.

Why are we doing this?

OAMF members came together because numerous legislative bills and policies are being introduced and implemented in many states (including Ohio) that mandate medical procedures or seek to strip Americans of their right to decline medical procedures. One example is influenza vaccine mandates in the workplace. Another is removing the reasons of conscience exemption for school vaccinations.

We alert and educate the public on legislation that impacts medical freedom and informed consent. It is important that people become aware because threatening legislation is being passed by our governing bodies at an alarming rate. We also provide support for individuals who would like to further their commitment to fighting for medical freedom. We hope you will join us in our quest to educate others and protect the fundamental right to accept or decline medical procedures.



The freedom over what is done to our bodies is the most basic human freedom. Increasingly, this fundamental right is being taken away – by insurance companies, employers, and even lawmakers. Article 6 of the Universal Declaration on Bioethics and Human Rights says:

66 Any preventive, diagnostic and therapeutic medical intervention is only to be carried out with the prior, free and informed consent of the person concerned, based on adequate information. The consent should, where appropriate, be express and may be withdrawn by the person concerned at any time and for any reason without disadvantage or prejudice. 99
