RE: BETTER FLIP PROJECT

Dear LCOPEDA Board:

We are writing to you to express our concern over what we believe are serious irregularities regarding the LCOPEDA project known as The Better Flip. It is our understanding that Mr. Rantala and/or the Port Authority is acting in the capacity of general contractor for The Better Flip Project; and as Executive Director for the LCOPEDA, Mr. Rantala is responsible for overseeing all operations of the LCOPEDA.

Specifically, we are very concerned about the following:

- Initially funding for the project was set "Not to Exceed \$150,000;" and the costs associated with this project are now nearly double, (100 percent over the amount the LCOPEDA Board approved for the project by Resolution 2018-08 at its March 28, 2018 Board Meeting).
- 2. Lobbyists for Citizens, based on public records and other communications, has confirmed that there was at no time a budget for The Better Flip Project.
 - Pursuant to ORC Section 149.43, Lobbyists for Citizens made a public records request in a letter dated May 22, 2019 for a copy of the budget for the Better Flip Project (attached).
 - b. Mr. Rantala confirmed to Lobbyists for Citizens in writing in a letter dated May 28, 2019 that there was no budget for The Better Flip Project (attached).
 - Lobbyists for Citizens brought this matter to the attention of the Lake County Commissioners at their public meeting on May 30, 2019.
 - d. Commissioner Hamercheck stated, on the record, during the May 30, 2019 Commissioners Meeting that Mr. Rantala informed him there was a budget for The Better Flip Project as he was being given a tour of the Better Flip house. Lobbyists for Citizens presented to the Commissioners Mr. Rantala's signed letter that there was no budget. Commissioner Hamercheck assured Lobbyists for Citizens that he would look into the matter.
 - e. On June 6, 2019 Lobbyists for Citizens sent a follow-up email to Commissioner Hamercheck requesting a status update relative to his investigation into whether there was, in fact, a budget for The Better Flip Project. We also sent our public records request letter for copies of the Better Flip Budget Document provided by Mr. Mark Rantala to Commissioner Hamercheck (attached).
 - f. On June 13, 2019, Prosecutor Michael DeLeone emailed Lobbyists for Citizens stating the following: "I am in receipt of your public records requests to Commissioner Hamercheck and the Lake County Board of Commissioners. There are no

records responsive to your request. This notwithstanding, please see the attached documents that were provided to Commissioner Hamercheck by Mr. Rantala." (attached).

- g. Prosecutor DeLeone's email response indicates, based on content, that Mr. Rantala provided to Commissioner Hamercheck what amounts to nothing more than a checkbook register; NOT a budget (attached).
- 3. Were/are you, as Board members, aware that competitive bidding is required for port authority projects that exceed \$150,000 under ORC Section 4582.12?
- 4. As it appears by all indications that no budget exists for The Better Flip Project, as Mr. Rantala has confirmed in writing to Lobbyists for Citizens in responses to our public records requests, how did the Board and Mr. Rantala determine that the total funding amount for The Better Flip Project would be \$150,000?
- 5. The Better Flip Project is now nearly 100 percent (\$149,000) over the amount approved by the LCOPEDA Board by unanimous adoption of Resolution No. 2018-08 (Not to exceed \$150,000). Does the Board believe it is reasonable that the additional \$149,000 was due solely to unforeseen circumstances? Does the Board believe the \$299,000 was a proper application of public funds?
- 6. It would appear that because there is no budget for The Better Flip Project, the amount that was requested by Mr. Rantala and which was presented to the Board for consideration in Resolution No. 2018-08 to fund The Better Flip Project was either completely arbitrary, or was set specifically not to exceed the threshold for competitive bidding under ORC 4582.12, which is \$150,000. Does the Board believe this was proper?
- 7. Are you aware that work on the project was performed by contractors that were not registered with the City of Willowick?
- 8. Are you aware that work was performed and contractors were paid for their work before permits were properly obtained with the Lake County Building Inspector? When asked directly about contractors being paid before permits were properly obtained, the Lake County Building Inspector indicated that the Port Authority may have just prepaid for the services rather than doing the work first and being inspected after the fact. Does the Board believe all required permits, work and inspections were performed in compliance with building code and jurisdictional requirements? If not, does the Board believe someone should be accountable for this failure to comply?
- 9. It seems pretty clear to Lobbyists for Citizens that Mr. Rantala was dishonest with Commissioner Hamercheck relative to there being a budget for The Better Flip Project. Could it be that Mr. Rantala was dishonest with the Port Authority Board as well? Does the Board believe it is proper to deceive a County Commissioner?
- 10. Lobbyists for Citizens is of the opinion that Mr. Rantala refuses to be managed by the LCOPEDA Board and has brazenly publicly at an LCOPEDA Board meeting admonished Board members and even mocked Commissioner Hamercheck when he raised concerns that the Better Flip Project, based on information he knew at the time, would be in excess of \$240,000-\$250,000. With the Board members statements, as well as Commissioner Hamercheck's statements now proving to have been conservative, does the Board condone Mr. Rantala's unprofessional behavior?

Please accept this letter as our formal request that the Board take a position on the above listed concerns. We further ask that the Board and Mr. Rantala, as Executive Director, of the Lake County Ohio Port & Economic Development Authority, take action to avoid this crisis of confidence; or worse.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LAKE COUNTY OHIO PORT AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO CREATE AND FUND AN ACCOUNTING LINE ITEM WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND OF THE PORT AUTHORITY FOR PAYMENT OF COSTS RELATED TO THE PORT AUTHORITY'S 'BETTER FLIP' DEMONSTRATION PROJECT LOCATED IN THE CITY OF WILLOWICK, WHICH COSTS ARE ANTICIPATED TO BE REIMBURSED UPON THE SALE OF THE BETTER FLIP DEMONSTRATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Lake, Ohio created the Lake County Ohio Port and Economic Development Authority (the LCOPEDA OR "Lake Port") pursuant to Sections 4582.21 through 4582.59 of the Ohio Revised Code (the "Port Act") to carry out the "authorized purposes" of the Port Act, including among others, activities that enhance, foster, aid, provide or promote housing and economic development; and

WHEREAS, this Board has previously authorized and approved the Executive Director of the LCOPEDA to execute and deliver such documentation and instruments as may be necessary or required in order for the LCOPEDA to accept and receive title to a home owned by the Lake County Land Reutilization Corporation ("Land Bank") located at 557 E. 305th Street in Willowick, Ohio in order to commence the LCOPEDA's Better Flip Demonstration Project;

WHEREAS, in order to provide for payment of predevelopment and development costs related to the redevelopment and improvement of the Better Flip Demonstration Project, staff of the Lake Port is requesting this Board to authorize the Executive Director of the Lake Port to establish an accounting line item within the General Fund of the LCOPEDA and authorize the funding of that line item in an amount not to exceed \$150,000 to account for and pay costs related to the construction, improvement and marketing of the Better Flip Demonstration Project;

WHEREAS, staff has requested that the Better Flip Demonstration Project line item be funded using moneys currently in the reserves of the LCOPEDA general fund and further anticipates that such moneys advanced to pay costs of the Better Flip Demonstration Project are anticipated to be reimbursed using proceeds of the sale of the Better Flip Demonstration Project upon completion of construction of the improvement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Lake County Ohio Port and Economic Development Authority

Section 1. This Board hereby authorizes and approves the Executive Director of the LCOPEDA to establish a line item within the General Fund of the LCOPEDA entitled "Better Flip Demonstration Project" so as to account for and be used for payment of predevelopment and development costs related to the redevelopment and improvement of the Better Flip Demonstration Project.

Section 2. This Board further authorizes the Executive Director to fund the Better Flip Demonstration Project line item hereby established through an accounting transfer of an amount not to exceed \$150,000 from the reserves line item in the LCOPEDA General Fund to the newly established Better Flip Demonstration Project line item in the General Fund.

Section 3. The Executive Director is hereby authorized to use moneys in the newly established Better Flip Demonstration Project line item within the general fund in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the LCOPDEA and Ohio law in order to provide for and pay costs related the development, improvement and marketing of the Better Flip Demonstration Project.

Section 4.
