

Female-headed households are more than twice as likely as all Ohio **households** to live in poverty.


Educational Attainment

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



Health & Wellness Indicators



Women in the county **do not have** access to a safety net health center that is community-based and provides services to all residents, including those without insurance.

86.9% of working-age women in Geauga County have health insurance.





The age-adjusted chronic disease mortality rate for women in the county is lower than for women across the state. This mortality rate includes cancers, stroke, diabetes, kidney disease, lower respiratory disease and heart disease.



Cervical cancers are largely preventable and can be diagnosed early by Pap tests. Yet about **6 in 10** diagnoses of cervical cancer among women in the county are late stage, when risk of mortality is higher.


Maternal Health

Teen pregnancies are overwhelmingly unplanned and impact education completion and future earnings. Preterm birth is associated with maternal smoking, infection, chronic disease and chronic maternal stress and is a driver of infant mortality.
