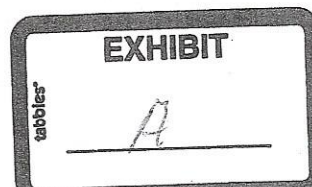
In Re: Alternate Local Government Fund Formula for Lake County R.C. 5747.53

Dear Mayor Ranallo:

The Lake County Budget Commission has received notice from the Lake County Board of Commissioners requesting that the 1982 agreement setting an alternative local government fund formula be abolished. The parties to this agreement are the Lake County Board of Commissioners, all Lake County municipal corporations and townships, and the Metropolitan Park. In 1995 the Painesville Township Park District was added as a party. Pursuant to the terms of this agreement, the Lake County Budget Commission is now required to appoint a committee to recommend either abolition or a new alternate formula pursuant to the procedures specified in R.C. 5747.53.

In order to give every political subdivision an opportunity to provide input into this matter, the committee shall be composed of one representative from every party to the agreement. The Lake County Budget Commission is requesting that each party appoint one representative to this committee. The name of the representative should be submitted to the Lake County Auditor by March 30, 2012. The Auditor will notify each political subdivision of the committee members' names and will suggest a date and location for a first organizational meeting. At the organizational meeting, the committee should appoint a chairman and other officers, establish procedures for addressing the abolition and/or amendment of the alternative formula and set any future meetings.


Once the committee has agreed to either abolish the current alternative local government formula or to amend the alternative formula, the proposal must be submitted to each political subdivision. In adopting the committee's proposal, each party shall act by motion. Pursuant to R.C. 5747.53(B), such motion shall take effect immediately and need not be published. In order for the committee's proposal to be adopted, it must receive an affirmative vote from (1) the Board of County Commissioners, (2) the City of Mentor, and (3) a majority of the remaining municipal corporations and townships. Although the Metropark and the Painesville Township Park District were made a parties, under RC 5747.53 neither have a vote in this matter.

The Lake County Budget Commission has received notice from every political subdivision designating their representative. Attached is a list of each representative's name.

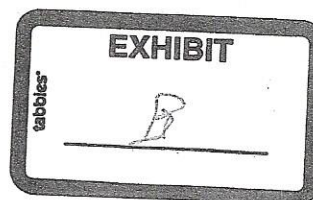
