TEAM MORENO FUNDRAISING NOTICE

Federal law requires us to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation, and name of employer for each individual whose aggregate contributions exceed \$200 in a calendar year.

Team Moreno is a joint fundraising committee comprised of and authorized by Bernie Moreno for Senate, NRSC, Ohio Republican Party State Central & Executive Committee ("State Party") and Best at Bringing Entrepreneurial Results Never Imagined or Envisioned PAC (Best BERNIE PAC) ("LPAC"). The maximum amount an individual or non-multicandidate PAC (multicandidate PAC in parenthesis) may contribute to Team Moreno is \$314,000 (\$130,000). Joint fundraising proceeds shall be allocated among the committees as follows:

1. The first \$3,300 (\$5,000) to Bernie Moreno for Senate Primary 2024 election debt retirement, until such debt is extinguished;
2. The next \$3,300 (\$5,000) to Bernie Moreno for Senate General 2024 election account;
3. The next \$41,300 (\$15,000) annually to NRSC General Account;
4. The next \$10,000 (\$5,000) annually to State Party;
5. The next \$5,000 (\$5,000) annually to LPAC;
6. The next \$3,300 (\$5,000) to Bernie Moreno for Senate Recount Fund;
7. The next \$123,900 (\$45,000) annually to NRSC Legal Proceedings Fund;
8. The remainder, up to \$123,900 (\$45,000) annually, to NRSC Building Account.

Notwithstanding this allocation method set forth above, any contributor may designate his or her contribution for a particular participant. In addition, the allocation formula may change if a contributor makes a contribution which would exceed the maximum legal amount that a contributor may give to a particular participant.

Contributions to Team Moreno are not tax deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. Contributions by corporations, labor unions, foreign nationals, and federal government contractors are prohibited.

BERNIE MORENO

Bernie Moreno fights for the American dream because he's lived it.

Bernie was born in Bogota, Colombia. At age five, his American dream began when he moved with his parents and six siblings to the United States. Bernie became an American citizen at age 18.

His mother instilled at an early age the value of hard work. From age 10, he held jobs from newspaper delivery boy to bagging groceries. As he went to school, his jobs became centered around cars – at manufacturers and industry magazines.

Bernie's career as a dealership owner began in 2005 with the purchase of one small, struggling dealership on Cleveland's West Side. He made his company one of the largest luxury dealers in the country and the largest in the Midwest.

Moreno maintained a simple business philosophy: His customers and colleagues should have a positive and memorable experience. This is part of why his companies have been named among the "Best Places to Work" by The Plain Dealer.

More recently, in 2016, Bernie recognized the value and transformational potential of blockchain technology, before it received mainstream attention, and moved much of his volunteer time and investment dollars into the space. In 2018 he co-founded ChampTitles, which eliminates the need for States to issue paper titles. The company has grown to be quite successful as Bernie served as Chairman of the Board. He recently sold his entire stake in the company and is no longer Board Chair.

While leading his companies, Bernie served many community organizations, including Cleveland State University, Cuyahoga Community College Foundation, The Cleveland Foundation, The Greater Cleveland Partnership, Destination Cleveland, Ohio Business Roundtable, Young Presidents Organization, The Fifty Club of Cleveland, and as a member of the Governor's Ohio Task Force on Community-Police Relations.

After a long, successful career, Bernie sold most of his business to begin focusing on his calling: protecting the American dream for another generation. He saw the government calling some



people essential and other hardworking Ohioans "unessential." He saw schools shut down and China go unpunished for unleashing a virus on the world. He saw politicians afraid to take on the CCP for stealing our jobs and technology; buying our farmland; and influencing young minds via TikTok and Confucius Institutes.

As an entrepreneur, Bernie was a bottom-up leader. He listened to the people actually doing the work to improve systems and make his businesses more efficient. As a U.S. Senator, Bernie will follow that same model. He will listen to Ohioans – not lobbyists and politicians – to determine what can help make our communities safer and more prosperous.

Bernie went from failing kindergarten for not speaking English to employing thousands of Ohioans in new, good-paying jobs. He knows what it is to be outcast, and what it is to be at the top of his industry.

It's because he kept it simple: He remains always optimistic and forward looking. He appreciates the value of education and hard work. He keeps family and faith at the center of his life. He holds dear his mother's lesson that we are all Americans first. And he believes the most important byproduct of success is to give back to the country that has offered him so much.

Of Bernie's many roles, his most loved are spending time at home in Westlake, Ohio, with his wife of 34 years, Bridget, and visiting their four adult children.
