

FY2025 Preliminary Reports for 900 Program

In FY2025 so far, there have been 217 offenders admitted to the 900 program. Sixteen (16) offenders entered as Intervention in Lieu of Conviction cases, 195 offenders entered as ISP probationers, and five (5) offenders entered as Judicial Release cases (which require an initial period of ISP supervision).

In FY2025 so far, 159 offenders have been terminated from the ISP program. Overall, approximately fifty-nine percent (59%) were successful terminations, approximately forty percent (40%) were unsuccessful, one percent (1%) were categorized as “other” terminations. Among the six (6) terminated Intervention cases, five (5) were successful terminations, and one (1) was categorized as “other” termination. Among the five (5) terminated Judicial Release cases, four (4) were successful, and one (1) was unsuccessful. The remaining 148 terminations so far in FY2024 were offenders receiving ISP supervision. Eighty-five (85) of those were successful terminations, sixty-two (62) were unsuccessful, and one (1) was categorized as “other” termination.

FY2025 Preliminary Reports for 950 Program

In FY2025 so far, there have been 148 offenders admitted to 950 programs:

Aftercare: sixteen (16)

Electronic Monitoring: seventy-two (72)

Decision Points: forty-nine (49)

Anger Management: four (4)

Transitional Day Reporting: seven (7)

In FY2025 so far, there have been 128 offenders terminated from 950 programs:

Aftercare: nine (9) successful, seven (7) unsuccessful

Electronic Monitoring: sixty-three (63) total, all successful

Decision Points: forty-four (44) successful, one (1) unsuccessful, one (1) “other”

Anger Management: two (2) total, both successful

Transitional Day Reporting: one (1) termination (successful)
